The CitySprouts Summer Youth Internship runs for six weeks and is open to 11-14 year olds. The internship is no cost, and youth who complete it *fully* receive a \$150 stipend. Youth must be available for the entire six-week session (youth can miss 4 days for excused absences).

As a CitySprouts Intern you will:

- Grow and cook food from the garden
- Build teamwork and leadership skills
- Perform STEM activities (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math)
- Eat lunch with your team every day
- Learn about and act on social justice issues
- Spend lots of time outside
